



## **42<sup>nd</sup> Journée des Jeunes Espoirs (JJE)**

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** The SCDE reserves the right to cancel the competition on a short notice if the COVID-19 situation requires such a decision and/or based on governmental recommendations. In such a situation, the entry fees will be reimbursed to the clubs.

In order to reduce the number of swimmers present at the same time in the swimming pool building, the events for girls and boys have been separated and sessions 1 & 3 are for **WOMEN** only - sessions 2 & 4 are for **MEN** only.

Please refer to the ANNEX COVID-19 for more details re the specific rules and processes applied in order to ensure that the meeting takes place respecting the necessary distance and hygiene rules.

The Meet will take place on Saturday and Sunday, October 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> 2020 at the swimming pool of the 'Lycée Technique Ettelbruck'.

### **RULES and REGULATIONS of the "42<sup>nd</sup> Journée des Jeunes Espoirs"**

1. The "42<sup>nd</sup> Journée des Jeunes Espoirs" is organized by the Swimming Club 'Le Dauphin Ettelbruck' and will be held under the rules of FINA and the Luxembourg Swimming Federation (FLNS).
2. FINA has classified the JJE 2020 as a competition where swimmers can achieve the FINA A and B Swimming Qualifying Standard Times for the FINA World Swimming Championships in Abu Dhabi 2021.
3. Any swimmer who is member of a team or National Federation, registered with FINA, may participate.
4. Pool: The competition will take place at the pool of the Lycée Technique Ettelbruck. The address is: 71, Avenue Lucien Salentiny, L-9080 Ettelbruck (Luxembourg). The pool is 25m long and has 5 lanes, SWISS TIMING electronic time keeping system, Omega OSB11 starting blocks with backstroke ledges and an electronic scoreboard. Live results of the competition will be published on the internet ([www.scde.lu](http://www.scde.lu)).

5. The age categories per year of birth (YOB) are:

KIDS:	2012 & younger
YOUNGSTERS:	2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011
TEENAGERS:	2006-2007
OLDIES:	2005 & older

6. Entry deadline: 8 pm Friday, 9<sup>th</sup> October 2020

Every participating club will receive an electronic confirmation of its entries.

9. The entry-fees are 5€ per event. There will be no refunds for absent swimmers!  
No replacements or additions will be accepted after the entry deadline.

10. Prices

- KIDS medal for each participant
- YOUNGSTERS medal for the first 3 swimmers (per YOB) of each event
- TEENAGERS medal for the first 3 swimmers of each event
- OLDIES money prize for the 5 swimmers (women & men separated) having the most points:

1st: 50€; 2nd: 40€; 3rd: 30€; 4th: 20€; 5th: 10€.

In each event, points are allocated to the first 5 swimmers (1st: 10 pts, 2nd: 8 pts, 3rd: 6 pts; 4th: 5 pts; 5th: 4 pts). The total number of points collected by a swimmer across all his races will be taken into account. In the case that two or more swimmers have the same number of points, individual placing will be considered.

Depending on the COVID-19 situation, the organizer reserves the right to cancel all victory ceremonies. In such a situation, medals and prizes will be given at the end of the meeting to a representative of each club for distribution to the winners.

11. Each club is requested to bring officials to ensure that the competition can take place.
12. If necessary, the SCDE may modify the time-schedule, cancel any scheduled breaks and ask clubs to reduce the number of entries should the meeting be oversubscribed. Information about possible changes will be provided in due time.
13. Media: the competition will be covered by photographers and cameras. By registering you allow SCDE to cover the event and publish material on their website, YouTube and/or other social media.
14. The Swimming Club 'Le Dauphin Ettelbruck' denies all responsibility for robbery, accidents or any kind of damage.
15. COVID-19: Please refer to the Annex for further information re the distance and hygiene rules and regulations applicable to the JJE 2020 and to be respected by all participants (athletes, coaches, volunteers and spectators).
